Journey : From Sealdah Railway Station at 19:40 hours by 13147 UTTAR BANGA EXP. / From Nabadwip Dham Rly. Stn. at 20:22 hours by 15959 KAMRUP EXP. on 27th April, 2024. Destination – NJP Rly. Stn.
